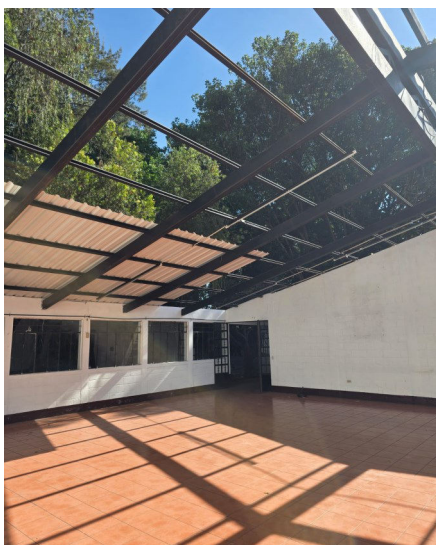
Kitchen Renovation Project

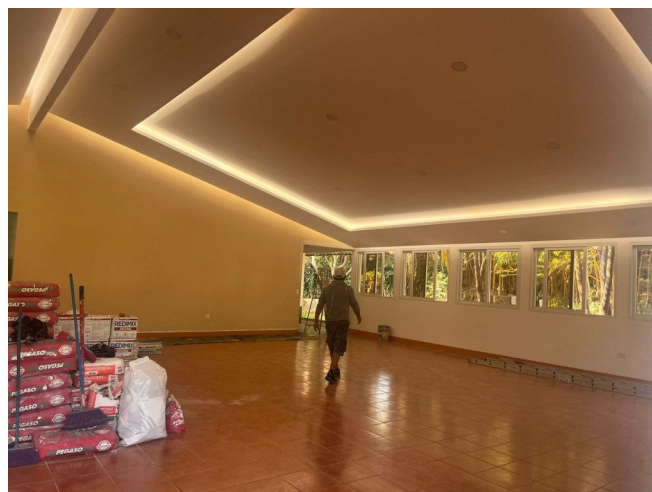
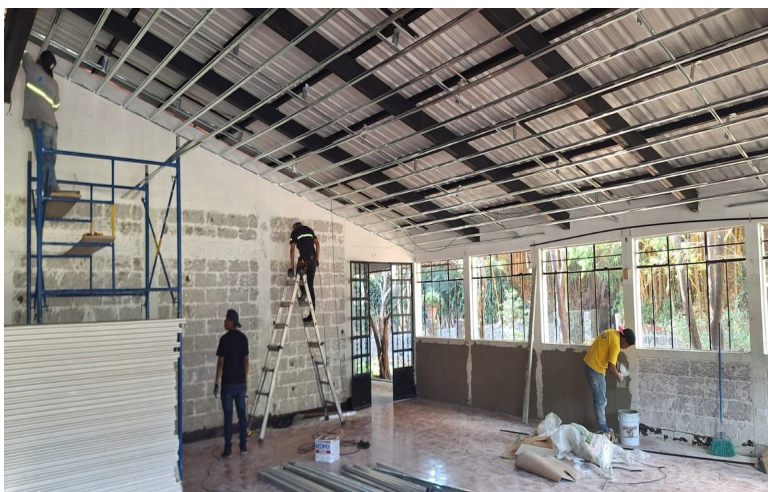

Dining Room Remodeling Project

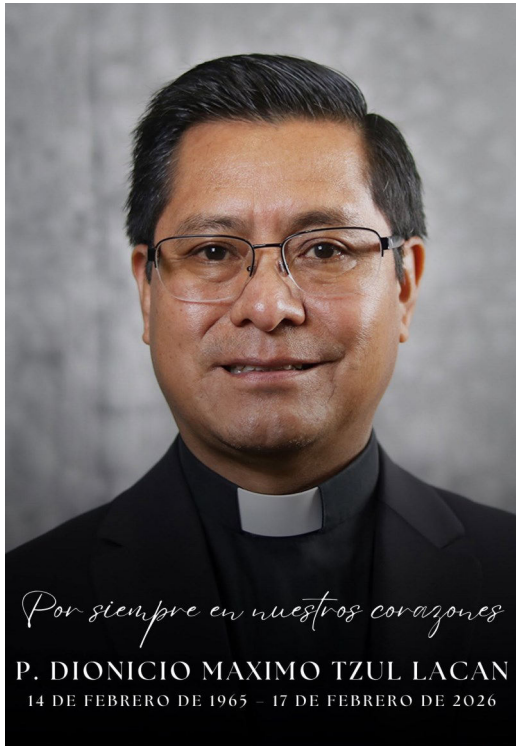

In Memory of the Deceased of the MFM



Sadly, Fr. Max Tzul passed away on February 17th, 2026, in San Bernardino, California, from aggressive leukemia.

Fr. Max was born in Guatemala on February 14, 1965. He was ordained a priest on April 4, 1996.

Fr. Max, was well known in Wisconsin because he served in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee at Holy Family Parish, Fond du Lac, from 2011 to January 2018, and at the parishes of St. Raphael, Prince of Peace, and St. Vincent de Paul from February 2018 to June 2021.

After Milwaukee, he served at the Diocese of San Bernardino from July 2021 to June 2025 in the Immaculate Conception Parish, in Colton, CA.

We thank the Archdiocese of Milwaukee for its support and for the welcome it gave him as he carried out his ministry.
